Pray Harold will learn quickly how to do the changing of the chemo bag. A nurse will be coming to their home to teach him. Imogene knows that God is in control, but still it is disappointing that her transplant is postponed for a couple of months.

## ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

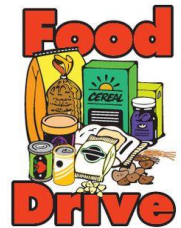
